Profile Summary

Madhi in collaboration with the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) Tamil Nadu will implement the Literacy and Language Development Programme(LLDP) across several districts in the state to improve foundational literacy skills and build the capacities of teachers and teacher coaches in government primary and middle schools. Madhi also runs the Transformational Academic Programme (TAP) in 15 schools run by the Greater Chennai Corporation to improve student learning outcomes. Madhi is conceptualising a platform that will act as a resource bank for teachers and teacher coaches across the State, working in under-resourced context.

Manager, Content Development will lead the process of ideation and design of content (lesson plans, worksheets, supplementary audio-visual material) to be used as part of the programmes, in order to ensure we deliver high-quality content that are aligned to the respective programmatic goals.

Responsibilities

- **Ideation:**
 - Contribute to the vision-setting process for the content to be used for the programmes
 - Lead the process of ideation for the various sub-projects, including the design of training collaterals (audio-video content like classroom simulation videos etc.)
- **Execution**
 - Script high-quality lesson plans that will lead to student mastery
 - Create and review worksheets created in alignment with the lesson plans
 - Enact classroom scenarios per the requirement of the video script
 - Record audio lessons for the consumption of the teachers
 - Observe classrooms/trainings to increase understanding of the context and continually work on creating relevant content
- **Planning:**
 - Set the schedule for content production and delivery and meticulously track the progress and ensure timely completion of projects
 - Raise concerns over delivery deadlines or resource optimisation to the Senior Manager, Content Development or Director in a timely manner.
- **Manage team:**
 - Ensure requisite tracking and monitoring mechanisms exist to ensure all team members are clear about their respective deliverables and are adequately supported to deliver their respective assignments on time.
- **Quality Control:**
 - Support the Senior Manager, Content Development or Director by offering feedback to improve quality of content offerings
 - Review content created by the team and ensure content created adheres to Madhi's quality standard and guidelines
